


Section 52063

- Develop a District English Learner Advisory Committee to provide advice to the Governing Board about the LCAP

Section 52062

- Present the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) to the Parent Advisory Committee for review and comment, with the Superintendent responding to committee comments in writing




