- I. **Call to Order:** Andrew Krowne, PAC Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 10:04 a.m. and welcomed the members in attendance.

Mr. Andrew Krowne, Chairperson, mentioned that there is no transparency and a lack of communication with LAUSD administrators following the death of a student at Reseda Charter. He notes that parents were not properly informed that the death may have been the

result of a fight at the school, which raises serious concerns about student safety. The PAC chairperson highlighted several main issues.

- The possible need for increased police presence at schools.
- The lack of responsibility and accountability among administrators.
