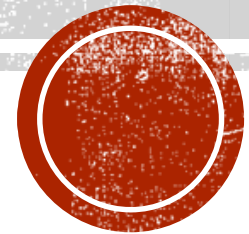

PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Conduct psycho-educational assessments
- Interpret findings of individual case studies
- Evaluate the results of tests
- Participate in Individualized Education Program (IEP) meetings
- Counsel Students (General Education, DIS Counseling, and ERICS)
- Collaborate with teachers
- Consult with parents
- Provide professional development
- Participate in prevention and intervention activities (MTSS)

Psychological Services is a large part of the SELPA – Local Plan which provides comprehensive special education programs and services for students with exceptional needs.

PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES / EDUCATIONALLY RELATED INTENSIVE COUNSELING SERVICES (ERICS)

LAUSD is responsible for the delivery of Psychological Services/Educationally Related Intensive Counseling Services (ERICS) for eligible students.

ERICS is on the continuum of related services under Designated Instructional Services (DIS)



PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES / EDUCATIONALLY RELATED INTENSIVE COUNSELING SERVICES (ERICS)

A special education assessment will be conducted by a credentialed LAUSD school psychologist when a student's counseling needs, in relation to behavior and emotional support, are greater in terms of frequency, duration, and/or intensity.

These needs are manifested in school, home, and community settings and affect the student's ability to access their educational program.

ERICS AS A RELATED SERVICE

- ERICS is for students whose social-emotional and behavioral needs are documented to be **more severe** in frequency, duration, or intensity; affect their ability to benefit from their special education program; and are manifested at school, at home, and in the community.
- ERICS is an intensive educationally related counseling service that **may** include individual counseling and group counseling, as needed.

ERIC'S DATA

- As of Nov. 3rd, the Welligent Services Report 300GA records reports that there were **2,319** students district-wide who are receiving ERICS

Focus is on the IEP - **Goals** – Social Emotional

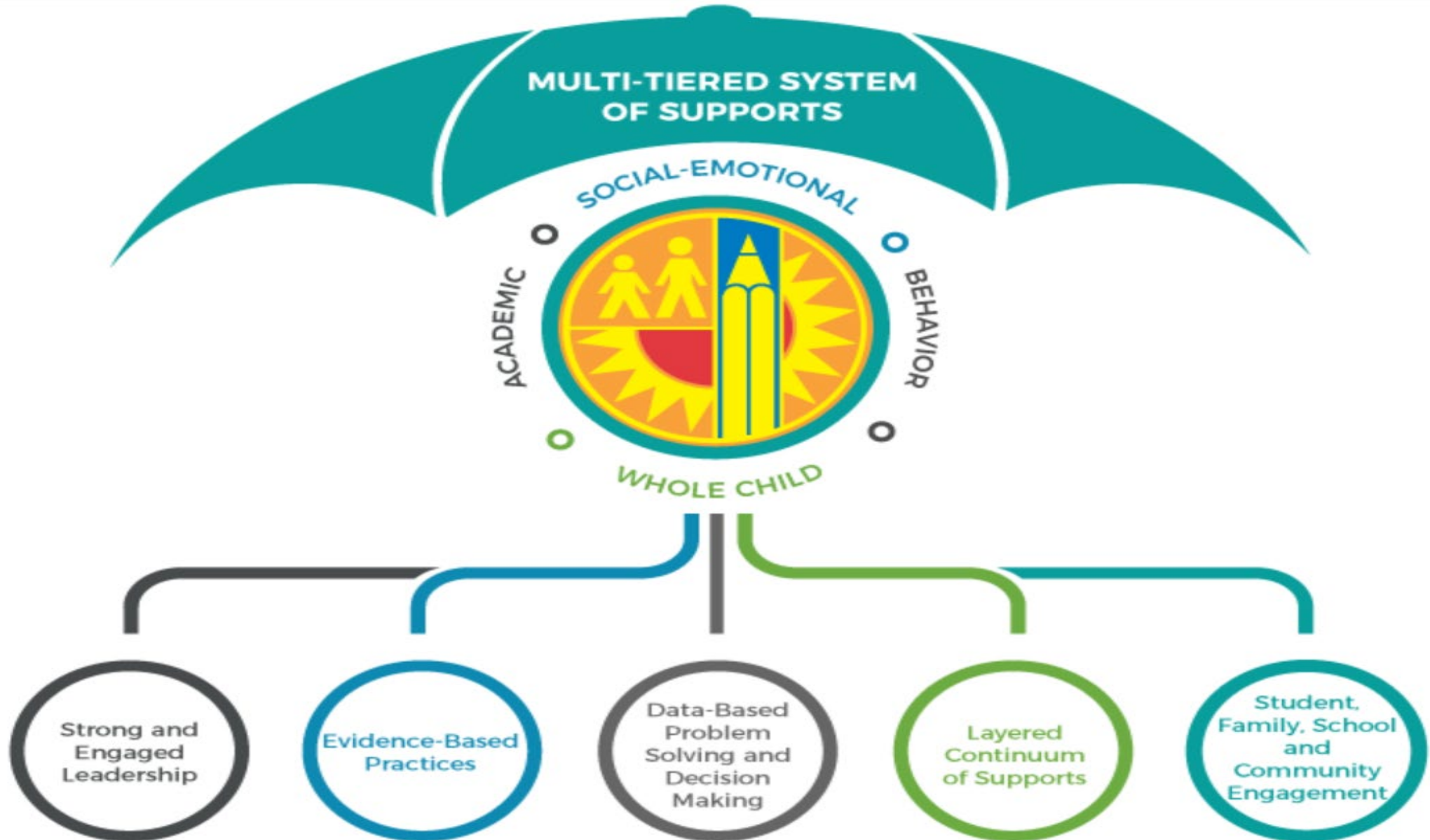

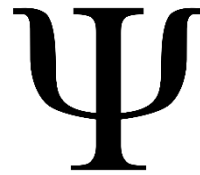
