Our office is excited to announce three distinct luncheons for the district level committees where we will apply District safety precautions as we honor your services to the Los Angeles Unified. You will receive a communication about scheduling a COVID-19 test **seven days** prior to the luncheon with Los Angeles Unified through the DailyPass.lausd.net, or with your selected provider. In order to participate in person, a negative COVID-19 test must be available in the Daily Pass site. If you decide to get a test with an external provider, you will need to upload the results to the site **three days** prior to the event. The luncheon is an optional activity for members alone and the program will include the opportunity to follow on Zoom for those who choose to participate from their home. Children and guests will not be able to attend for safety reasons and due to seating restrictions. Childcare and mileage reimbursement will be provided for members. The date for the **CAC** luncheon is Thursday, June 24 from **10:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.** Specific details and a survey to confirm your attendance will reach you in a few days.

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Responsibilities Assigned to the CAC

The CAC shall advise the school district governing board on at least the following tasks:

1. Advising the policy and administrative entity of the special education local plan area regarding the development, amendment, and review of the local plan. The entity shall review and consider comments from the community advisory committee.
2. Recommending annual priorities to be addressed by the plan.
3. Assisting in parent education and in recruiting parents and other volunteers who may contribute to the implementation of the plan.
4. Encouraging community involvement in the development and review of the local plan.
5. Supporting activities on behalf of individuals with exceptional needs.
6. Assisting in parent awareness of the importance of regular school attendance.
7. Supporting community involvement in the parent advisory committee established pursuant to Section 52063 to encourage the inclusion of parents of individuals with exceptional needs to the extent these pupils also fall within one or more of the definitions in Section 42238.01
