

PUBLIC COMMENT

Members of the public are invited to address the LAUSD Central Committees whenever they meet in open session, in accordance with the specific guidelines below:

- **Speakers for public comment must sign up on a first-come, first-served basis at the meeting.**
- **No slot for public comment will be held or reserved by proxy.**
- **Each speaker will be allowed a single appearance at the public comment time.**
- **A time allotment of 2 minutes will be provided to a maximum of 5 people.**



The following are the instructions for how to sign up for public comment:

- 1. Interested speakers for public comment can register at the Dutch door by the Parent and Community Services (PCS) main office.**
- 2. The Dutch door will open for public comment registration about a half an hour before the scheduled start time of the meeting.**
- 3. PCS staff will register speakers on a list in the order they are received.**
- 4. Speakers will be given numbers that reflect the order of their names on the list.**
