Unit C, Article XII.

5.0 Weekend Trips: Drivers who are unavailable for overtime weekend trips that are charged to their "overtime account" shall only be charged that amount of overtime the turned down trip actually took. Drivers who are unavailable for overtime due to illness, personal necessity or unpaid leave during the regular workweek shall be charged two (2) hours of overtime on the day absent.

- A. When a trip is offered and accepted by a driver, all trips are final.
- B. All trips shall allow the driver to cover the front and back end of the route received.
- C. If a trip is subject to cancellation after the driver has accepted the trip, the driver will receive the equivalent of their 6-hours.
- D. All radio check- ins will receive a minimum of 1-hour prior to sign on pick up time.
