RE: EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS (EPMC) TOWARDS CALPERS

This side letter states the agreement reached between the Los Angeles School Police Management Association ("LASPMA") and the Los Angeles Unified School District ("District") regarding the EPMC.

The parties agree that in order in order to address recent changes to CalPERS under the Public Employee Pension Reform Act of 2012 (PEPRA), effective July 1, 2014, all CalPERS eligible bargaining unit employees shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of his/her individual employee contribution to the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) at the rate fixed and prescribed by law.

Effective July 1, 2014, all regular members shall receive a 1.7% general wage increase to base pay in order to offset the elimination of EPMC.
