

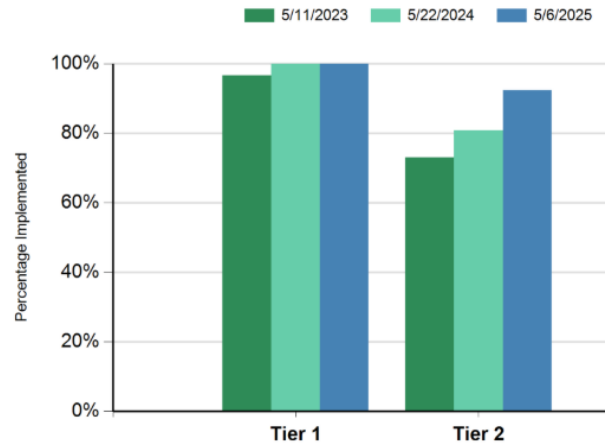


Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports (PBIS) Annual Summary

2024-2025

How are we implementing PBIS at our school in Tier I?

The Tiered Fidelity Inventory (our PBIS assessment) indicates that we are implementing Tier I above benchmark, at 100%. Over the past three years our continued efforts have helped us to grow at the tier 1 and tier 2 levels, which supports Tinicum Elementary School's continued recognition of implementing SWPBIS systems with fidelity. As a team, we have also identified items that we want to improve and included them in our Action Plan for the 2025-2026 school year. These items are outlined below.

What is our Office Discipline Referral rate?

Our referral rate was below the national average throughout most of the school year. Our data team meets regularly to review areas of strength and needs of the school building. Areas of strength are identified and shared to celebrate the success and continued growth of our schoolwide program. Strategic targeted interventions are carried out to reinforce tier 1 fidelity of implementation.

What have we done to implement PBIS at our school in Tier II?

This year we continued to use a universal screener to identify students for Tier II interventions. Current interventions include our buddy program, social skills groups, individual counseling, and our Race to Success program for positive behavior on the bus. We are looking forward to building on our Tier II interventions to support our students!

Our Action Plan for 2025-2026:

1. Provide continued professional development on SWPBIS at tier 1 and 2 levels
2. Implement fidelity checks throughout the year of SWPBIS systems
3. Restructure meeting teams and schedule to provide strategic support at all levels

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
