#### **Brief Description:**

(Approval of Facilities Contracts Actions) Recommends the ratification of Procurement Services Division contract actions taken by Facilities Contracts under delegated authority as listed in Attachment "A" including: award of advertised construction contracts; award of job order contracts; award of job order contract amendments; approval of change orders; completion of contracts; award of informal contracts; assignment and assumption of rights and delegation of duties; award of architectural and engineering contracts; extra services / amendments for architectural and engineering contracts and approved proposed contracts in Attachment B including fire life safety training and video creation services and materials testing and special inspection services contracts.

#### **Action Proposed:**

Ratify the Procurement Services Division (PSD) contract actions taken by Facilities Contracts under delegated authority as listed in Attachment "A" including: award of advertised construction contracts; award of job order contracts; award of job order contracts amendments; approval of change orders; completion of contracts; award of informal contracts; assignment and assumption of rights and delegation of duties; award of architectural and engineering contracts; extra services / amendments for architectural and engineering contracts and approved proposed contracts in Attachment B including fire life safety training and video creation services and materials testing and special inspection services contracts.

#### **Background:**

Facilities Contracts staff prepares monthly reports for contract actions necessary for the execution of projects approved by the Board and contained in the FSD Strategic Execution Plan (SEP), and for the maintenance and operation of District facilities in accordance with District policies and Board-delegated authority. As described in the November 12, 2013 Board Report #048-13/14 Informative, detailed information is provided on the Facilities Services website.

#### **Expected Outcomes:**

Approval of these items will allow services provided by these contracts to proceed in support of FSD projects, District policies and goals, and the Board-approved FSD-SEP.

## **Board Options and Consequences:**

The Board can approve all actions presented or postpone selected actions pending receipt of additional information. Non-ratification of actions awarded under delegated authority in Attachment "A" will result in the immediate discontinuance of services. While non-ratification may be legally defendable, it will likely result in costly litigation over discontinued payments or if the District attempts to reclaim payments made to a vendor. District costs will likely increase as fewer contractors compete for future procurements.

Authorization to award a formally competed contract selected from two (2) bids received to provide Fire Life Safety Training and Video Creation Services for Beaudry Building procured via RFP R-25024.

BSS will provide all training, content, videos, and services to remain current and in compliance with all applicable city codes and regulations. All site-specific content and videos will be hosted on a secure, District-managed platform (e.g., MyPLN) and remain valid for the duration of the contract.

The current training videos and certification programs, developed by BSS in the early 2000s, are becoming obsolete as BSS retires its legacy web-based platform. Additionally, concerns about potential cybersecurity risks have been raised by the Information Technology Services (ITS) Division.

Neither the District nor staff are approved by the City of Los Angeles to conduct on-line computer-based Fire/Life Safety Training. Additionally, the District does not have the resources in place to immediately develop a comprehensive life/safety training and certification program along with the necessary training videos that will meet and/or exceed the requirements outlined in Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) 57.408. The selected vendor must maintain a valid Los Angeles Fire Department Certificate of Fitness to perform high-rise life safety services in the City of Los Angeles and must also be approved by the City to conduct on-line computer-based Fire/Life Safety Training.

Without approval the District risks regulatory non-compliance with LAMC 57.408 which could lead to penalties from the City of Los Angeles and potential building closure due to restriction on occupancy.
