- 3. The furnishing or use of any copyrighted or uncopyrighted composition, secret process, patented or unpatented invention, article, or appliance under the Contract Documents; and
  - 4. As otherwise provided in the Contract Documents.

The CONTRACTOR at its own cost, expense, and risk, shall defend all legal proceedings that may be brought against all such potential indemnities for any such liability, claim, loss, cause of action, action, demand, penalty, cost and expense, and satisfy any resulting judgment that may be rendered against any of them whether or not the liability, claim, loss, cause of action, action, demand, penalty, cost and expense (including without limitation, attorneys' fees) was actually or allegedly caused wholly or in part through the negligence or other tortious conduct of any of them.     - (c) For which there is any obligation to share damages with or repay someone else who must pay damages because of the injury described in Paragraphs (1)(a) or (b) above; or
    - (d) Arising out of his or her providing or failing to provide professional health care services.

However:

Paragraphs (1)(a) and (1)(d) do not apply to your "employees" or "volunteer workers," who are not employed by you or volunteering for you as health care professionals, for "bodily injury" arising out of Good Samaritan Acts while the "employee" or "volunteer worker" is performing duties related to the conduct of your business. Good Samaritan Acts mean any assistance of a medical nature rendered or provided in an emergency situation for which no remuneration is demanded or received.

#### 2. Newly Acquired or Formed Organization

If coverage for newly acquired or formed organizations is not otherwise excluded from this Coverage Part, Paragraph **3.a.** is amended to read:

- a. Coverage under this provision is afforded until the end of the policy period;
- **3.** Each of the following is also an insured:
  - a. Managers and Supervisors Your managers and supervisors are also insureds, but only with respect to their duties as your managers and supervisors. 
