

What do I need to do?

- If applying to a Gifted Magnet or Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) and enrolled in a non-district school (private, independent charter), confirm that the school of attendance has submitted the Verification of Eligibility form on or before the November 12, 2021 deadline (email or postmarked). (NOTE: A Verification of Eligibility form is NOT required for Gifted Magnet/SAS applicants currently enrolled in a Los Angeles Unified school, including online instruction with City of Angels. Upon receipt of the application, the District will automatically review eligibility through a District verification process in January 2022.)
- If applying to a Gifted Magnet or Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) and homeschooled (without a verifying organization) or not enrolled in school, contact GATE@lausd.net on or before the November 12, 2021 deadline to initiate the verification process.
- If applying to a Highly Gifted Magnet, parents/guardians may contact Gifted/Talented Programs at (213) 241-4177 or GATE@lausd.net to verify eligibility.

- You may apply to one or more of the Choices programs on a single application.
- Before applying, please contact the school to obtain information regarding the school’s orientation meeting, tours, uniform requirements, bus route information (if applicable), and other pertinent information.
- Before applying, the parent/guardian must carefully review program eligibility criteria and verification procedures, if applicable.
- Submit a new application if the child’s name remained on a waiting list last year, if you wish to change from one program to another, or if your child will be culminating (e.g., from elementary or middle school).
- DO NOT submit a new application if your child is currently enrolled in a Choices program and wishes to continue in the same program.
- Multiple-birth applicants (e.g., twins, triplets) must reside at the same address and apply to the same program (first choice only) in the same year in order to be placed consecutively in the Choices selection process.
- Siblings of students who have left the school, have culminated, or will culminate this school year, do not have sibling priority. Siblings must reside at the same address at the time of application. It is the parent/guardian’s responsibility to verify that the siblings have the same address on file at the current Los Angeles Unified school of attendance by the application deadline.
- To receive sibling priority, parent/guardian must indicate each sibling on the Choices application and list all siblings in their Apply account. Sibling priority will be given to applicants whose siblings are currently enrolled at the same school/program to which they are applying.
- Parents/guardians will receive a notification of selection in mid-March. If selected, parent/guardian must accept or decline by the deadline on the Selection/Waiting List Letter. **If the parent/guardian’s response is not received by the deadline, it is considered a decline. All declines are final.**
- Parents/guardians can accept or decline online by logging into their apply.lausd.net account or by contacting the school before the deadline in their selection letter.
- You may only accept one Choices placement. Applicants currently enrolled in a Choices program who apply, are selected, and accept another Choices program will automatically be dropped from their current program.
- If the student does not get selected, he or she will be placed on a waiting list for his or her first choice ONLY within each applicable program. Your child’s name will remain on a waiting list regardless of whether you accept or decline another program. Affiliated Charter School applicants who are not selected will be placed on the waiting list for each Affiliated Charter School to which they applied.
- Students on a waiting list will be contacted directly by a representative from the school(s) if a seat becomes available.
- If you submit an application and would like to remove your application from the selection process, you must send an email to ApplyforSchools@lausd.net or mail your request by December 17, 2021, to: Unified Enrollment, P.O. Box 513307, Los Angeles, CA 90051
- Online Choices applications can be updated until November 12, 2021.
- If multiple on-time Choices applications are submitted for the same student, the first application received will be considered valid and all others will be disregarded.
- The 2022-23 CHOICES brochure and paper application are available online at goto.lausd.net or at Los Angeles Unified schools or offices.

Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten and First Grade Applicants

Pursuant to California Education Code Sections 46300, 48000, 48010 and Senate Bill 1381, a child is eligible for transitional kindergarten (TK) if a child will turn age 5 between September 2nd through December 2nd. Students entering kindergarten are required to be age 5 by September 1st, and students entering first grade are required to be age 6 by September 1st.

Students can only apply for a Choices program for which they meet the age requirements. Students must meet the age eligibility requirement regardless of current school year grade placement. All subsequent grade placement decisions are made by the school principal at the school of enrollment. Not all Choices programs or schools offer TK. Choices programs offering TK classes are listed in the Choices brochure.

Prior to admission of a child into transitional kindergarten, kindergarten, or first grade, the parent/guardian shall present proof that the child is of the minimum age for enrollment as required by law. Falsification of information will result in the applicant's removal from the program. It is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian to complete the application correctly.

HOW DOES THE LATE CHOICES PROCESS WORK?

- If you miss the on-time application window, you may submit late applications beginning February 1, 2022.
- Parent/guardian can submit late applications to as many programs as they wish. A separate late application must be submitted for each school.
- Submit late applications online at <https://apply.lausd.net> or mail to: Unified Enrollment, P.O. Box 513307, Los Angeles, CA 90051
- Permits With Transportation (PWT) does not accept late applications.
- No points, preferences, or priorities are assigned to late applications.
- Late applications are added to the end of the school's waiting list, if applicable, and applicants are contacted in the order received. Parent/guardian will be contacted by the school if/when a seat becomes available. Parent/guardian may be contacted up until the fourth week of the first semester or the second week of the second semester. Exceptions: Dual Language Education and Affiliated Charter School applicants remain on the waiting list until the end of the academic year to which they applied.
- Late applications do not impact the on-time application process. If you applied on-time and are on a school's waiting list, you do not need to submit a late application to the same program.
- Late applicants to Gifted/Highly Gifted Magnet Programs and Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) must meet required, program-specific criteria, however, verification of eligibility is processed at the school site. Verification of Eligibility forms for late applicants, if applicable, must be submitted directly to the school of choice when the parent/guardian is contacted by the school about an available seat. CRITERIA FOR GIFTED/HIGHLY GIFTED MAGNET PROGRAMS AND SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES

ALL CURRENT LOS ANGELES UNIFIED APPLICANTS: READ SECTIONS A, B AND C
ALL PRIVATE SCHOOL, INDEPENDENT CHARTER AND NON-LOS ANGELES UNIFIED APPLICANTS: READ SECTIONS A, B AND D

Prior to submitting an application, please review closely the sections indicated below to ensure that the application is completed accurately and on time. The application will be removed from the selection process if applicable criteria are not met by the deadline.

SECTION A: GIFTED MAGNET PROGRAMS AND SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES APPLICANTS

- ① Student has met program-specific eligibility criteria outlined in Section B. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to verify with the current school of attendance if the applicant has met the criteria before applying and that the **Verification of Eligibility form**, if applicable, has been submitted by the deadline.
- ② Student resides within Los Angeles Unified boundaries at the time of application and while participating/enrolled in the program.
- ③ If student is applying to a new school/program or matriculating from the 5th/6th or 8th grade (has completed elementary or middle school) the student must be **reverified** by the current school of attendance as eligible to continue in a Gifted Magnet Program or Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) site.
- ④ Applicant acknowledges that late verification will not be accepted and the recommendation submitted by the principal of the current school of attendance is final.

SECTION B: PROGRAM-SPECIFIC ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

REQUIRED CRITERIA FOR GIFTED MAGNET PROGRAMS OR SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES APPLICANTS

Gifted Magnet Programs and Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) offer enriched interdisciplinary academic environments that are exciting, challenging and encourage students to use creative/critical thinking skills. Both serve students who demonstrate the ability or strong potential to work two years above grade level in academic subjects and meet ONE of the criteria listed below. (To ensure equitable access, all criteria carry equal weight in the selection process.)

FOR AN APPLICANT TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A GIFTED MAGNET PROGRAM OR SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES, THE STUDENT MUST BE VERIFIED AS MEETING ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA PRIOR TO FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2021, AT 5:00 P.M.

- A) Student is identified as gifted by a Los Angeles Unified designated GATE psychologist in the Intellectual Ability, High Achievement Ability, Specific Academic Ability, Creative Ability or Leadership Ability category.**
 - Upon receipt of the application, the District will automatically check the applicant's eligibility through Los Angeles Unified school records.
 - If the applicant was identified as gifted in Los Angeles Unified, but is currently attending a private school, independent charter or non- Los Angeles Unified school, the parent/guardian must submit a Verification of Eligibility form to ensure that the applicant is included in the District database. **OR**
- B) Student received total national percentile scores of 85 or above on a District-approved standardized achievement test in 2021, if applicable. Note: Due to the elimination of the 2020-2021 Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC), this criterion has been modified for this year only. OR**
- C) Student demonstrates the ability to meet ALL FOUR critical thinking and problem-solving skills (in primary language):**
 - a) Explain meanings or relationships among facts, information or concepts that demonstrate depth and complexity
 - b) Formulate new ideas or solutions and elaborate on the information
 - c) Use alternative methods in approaching new or unfamiliar mathematical problems
 - d) Use extensive vocabulary easily and accurately to express creative ideas

The school of attendance will determine if your child demonstrates all four skills for this criterion (i.e., four critical thinking and problem-solving skills). Applicants verified through the four critical thinking and problem-solving skills criterion must also demonstrate the ability or strong potential to work two years above grade level in academic subjects. NOTE: Kindergarten SAS applicants must also be verified using the SAS kindergarten-specific criteria on the **Verification of Eligibility (SAS Kindergarten)** form.

REQUIRED CRITERIA FOR HIGHLY GIFTED MAGNET PROGRAM APPLICANTS

Highly Gifted Magnet Centers group students to allow for a demanding broad-based academic program that provides advanced educational opportunities designed to serve the needs, interests and goals of intellectually gifted students. Emphasis is placed on problem-solving and the development of higher-level thinking skills, as well as positive social-emotional growth.

Students eligible for Highly Gifted Magnet Programs are residents of Los Angeles Unified who meet:

- the highly gifted (HG) criterion score of 99.9 on an Intellectual Ability assessment administered by a Los Angeles Unified designated GATE psychologist **OR**
- the highly gifted applicable (HGA) criterion score (between 99.5–99.8) on an Intellectual Ability assessment administered by a Los Angeles Unified designated GATE psychologist.

ALL APPLICANTS INTERESTED IN A HIGHLY GIFTED MAGNET PROGRAM MUST BE ASSESSED AND IDENTIFIED PRIOR TO FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2021, TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ON-TIME APPLICATION AND SELECTION.

Students identified as HG/HGA are also eligible to apply to a Gifted Magnet Program or Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS).

Upon receipt of the application, the District will automatically check Los Angeles Unified records for eligibility. If the applicant was identified as highly gifted/highly gifted applicable in Los Angeles Unified and is currently attending a private school, independent charter or non-Los Angeles Unified school, the parent/guardian must submit a **Verification of Eligibility** form to ensure that the applicant is included in the District database. Parents/guardians may contact Gifted/Talented Programs at (213) 241-4177 or GATE@lausd.net to verify if the student is eligible to apply to a Highly Gifted Magnet Program.

NOTE: Los Angeles Unified provides programs for gifted/talented students at all local resident schools as well as at Magnets and Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS). In addition, some schools provide specialized services for highly gifted students (e.g., Highly Gifted Pathway at Peary Middle School and Wright Middle School). Please call the school or Magnet center you are interested in for further information on its Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) services and support.

SECTION C: LOS ANGELES UNIFIED APPLICANTS (CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN A LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL)

Although Los Angeles Unified applicants must meet the required program-specific criteria outlined in Section B, a **Verification of Eligibility** form is NOT required for applicants (applying to grades K-12) currently enrolled in a Los Angeles Unified school, including online instruction with City of Angels. Upon receipt of the application, the District will automatically review eligibility through a District verification process in January 2022. Please contact your child's Los Angeles Unified school of attendance for more information.

SECTION D: PRIVATE SCHOOL, INDEPENDENT CHARTER AND NON-LOS ANGELES UNIFIED APPLICANTS

The parents/guardians of private school, independent charter and non-Los Angeles Unified students who are applying to a Gifted Magnet Program or Schools for Advanced Studies must follow the procedures below. This includes incoming kindergarten SAS applicants who are attending a non-Los Angeles Unified preschool or transitional kindergarten (TK). It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to verify that the student's current school of attendance has submitted the required verification form by Friday, November 12, 2021, at 5:00 p.m.

For an applicant previously identified as gifted/highly gifted by a Los Angeles Unified designated GATE psychologist, who is currently attending a private school, independent charter or non-Los Angeles Unified school, the parent/guardian must submit a **Verification of Eligibility** form to ensure that the applicant is included in the District database.

REQUESTING VERIFICATION FROM CURRENT SCHOOL OF ATTENDANCE

OPTION 1:

- ① Visit eChoices.lausd.net to download the **Verification of Eligibility (SAS Kindergarten)** form or **Verification of Eligibility (Grades 1-12)** form. (Click "Who is eligible?" to access forms.)
- ② Complete the student and parent information sections, sign and date.
- ③ Provide the applicable form to the student's current school of attendance, giving the school permission to complete all required sections.

OPTION 2:

- ① Call the Choices Support Line at (213) 241-4177 or email giftedverification@lausd.net to request the appropriate **Verification of Eligibility** form.

SUBMITTING VERIFICATION FORMS

Once the **Verification of Eligibility** form has been completed by the school of attendance, school site personnel must submit the completed and signed form by Friday, November 12, 2021. The **Verification of Eligibility** form must be submitted in a sealed official school envelope with the principal's signature across the sealed side or emailed by the school. Email is the preferred submission method; the sender will receive an email confirmation. Do not submit the form with the application. Late forms will not be accepted.

NOTE: The **Verification of Eligibility** form is NOT an application. A **Verification of Eligibility** form must be submitted in addition to a Choices application prior to the deadline of Friday, November 12, 2021. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure that the completed **Verification of Eligibility** form is submitted by the school of attendance prior to the deadline. For applicants to SAS kindergarten who are not enrolled in preschool or TK, please contact Gifted/Talented Programs at (213) 241-4177 or GATE@lausd.net for information regarding verification procedures or visit achieve.lausd.net/gate (select Program Options and SAS). Program Eligibility Letters will be sent in February indicating an applicant's eligibility status for Gifted Magnet Programs and Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS). Selection/Waiting List Letters for eligible students will be sent in March. For information regarding verification for Choices late applicants to Gifted/Highly Gifted Magnet and SAS, please refer to page 6.

MAGNET PROGRAMS INFORMATION

WHAT ARE MAGNET PROGRAMS?

The Los Angeles Unified magnet schools/centers are a voluntary integration program that provide rigorous, high-quality, theme-based instruction designed to facilitate student learning and promote academic achievement. Established in 1977, the magnet programs within our District have been one of the most successful in the nation. Currently, there are 330 magnet programs located throughout the District. The approximate number of seats available in 2022-2023 and the number of applications submitted in 2021-2022 to each magnet school/center can be found under each school's name. All District students, including English learners, standard English learners, students with disabilities, and gifted/talented are encouraged to apply.

Some magnet programs occupy entire school sites (Full School Magnets), while others are magnet centers located on residential school campuses with access to activities and experiences shared with the host school. Please see pages 21-40 to review the magnet school/center information in this brochure and to determine the program(s) that fit your child's needs. Each of the magnet programs falls within one of eight instructional themes: Business, Communication Arts, Centers for Enriched Studies, Gifted and Highly Gifted, Liberal Arts, Public Service, Science/Technology/Engineering/Math or Visual and Performing Arts.

WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM?

Magnet programs embrace the interests of all students by focusing on thematic instruction and personalized learning. Magnet programs provide pathways that prepare students to pursue innovative careers in our evolving global economy.

Magnet programs were established through an integration court-order to address the Five Harms of Racial Isolation: Low Academic Achievement, Low Self-Esteem, Lack of Access to Post-Secondary Opportunities, Interracial Hostility and Intolerance and Overcrowded Conditions. They are in alignment with Los Angeles Unified's goals: 100 percent graduation, proficiency for all, 100 percent attendance, parent, community and student engagement, school safety, and building a solid foundation for early learners.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students who are in grades K-12 and live within the Los Angeles Unified boundary are eligible to apply for magnet programs. Applicants must be residents of Los Angeles Unified at the time of enrollment and while participating in the magnet program. The index of programs on pages 21-40 includes available grade levels for each program.

Only Gifted and Highly Gifted Magnets (pages 23-26) require specific eligibility criteria (pages 7-8) for selection. All applicants for Gifted and Highly Gifted Magnets must be identified or verified, and submit a magnet application.

HOW ARE STUDENTS SELECTED?

The on-time student selection process for magnet programs is based on the Magnet Priority Point System and the Court-Ordered reduction of the Harms of Racial Isolation. Once the application is submitted, the information is verified by the District's Information Technology Division (ITD) and students are assigned points based on 5 criteria (see Magnet Priority Point System on page 19). The sum of these points is utilized in the fair and computerized selection process. See page 20 for late application process.

It is the Parents'/Guardians' responsibility to verify the student's address, grade and ethnicity with the current Los Angeles Unified school of attendance prior to the application deadline.

Magnet priority points are only applicable to the magnet program. There are no points given for submitting an invalid (residing outside the district, applying to an incorrect grade level, etc.) or late application. Students who apply for the same grade twice will not earn waiting list points for the previous year.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- You may apply to three different magnet programs. However, you may apply to a single program, the second and third choices are optional.
- The Magnet Priority Points are used for the applicant's first and optional second or third choice.
- If not selected to their first choice, the applicant will be considered for their second and/or third choice.
- If selected to any one of their choices, the applicant will not be on the waiting list for the other choice(s).
- If not selected into a magnet program, the applicant will be placed on the waiting list for their first choice only.
- Applicants currently attending a magnet program and selected into another magnet program will automatically be dropped from their current magnet program.

WAITING LIST | Applicants who remained on a valid on-time magnet waiting list receive 4 points for the following year. Applicants may accumulate waiting list points for the prior three consecutive years for a maximum of 12 points. If an applicant on a waiting list declines magnet placement, ALL waiting list points are removed. New waiting lists are established each year. PREDOMINANTLY HISPANIC, BLACK, ASIAN AND OTHER NON-ANGLO (PHBAO) SCHOOLS | Applicants, whose 2022-2023 resident Los Angeles Unified school is designated as PHBAO by the District, receive 4 points. Points are not cumulative; they are assigned yearly.

OVERCROWDED | Applicants, whose 2021-2022 resident Los Angeles Unified school is designated as overcrowded by District criteria receive 4 points. Points are not cumulative; they are assigned yearly.

SIBLING | If an applicant is applying to the same magnet school/program in which a brother or sister will be continuing, he/she receives 3 points. **Points are assigned if the sibling is attending the applicant's 1st choice school.** Siblings must reside at the same address at the time of application, which must be reflected in the District's computer system. Each and every student must have an application on file, including twins, triplets, etc. **It is the parent's responsibility to verify that the siblings have the same address on file in the District's computer system at the current Los Angeles Unified school of attendance by the application deadline.**

- * Students enrolled at elementary schools who culminate at 6th grade will be assigned matriculation points at either 5th or 6th grade. Students currently enrolled in multi-level magnet schools (Eagle Rock HS Gifted, Franklin DLA, Fulton CAM, Lake Balboa CP, LAUSD/USC MAE, Los Angeles CES, Maywood CES, Science Academy STEM, Sherman Oaks CES, Sotomayor AS, Sun Valley BSEL and Valley Oaks CES magnets) do not receive matriculation points. Arroyo Seco, Laurel, Western Ave and Westside Global Awareness magnets are grades K-8 and receive matriculation points only at the eighth grade. Applicants will NOT be assigned both Matriculation and Waiting List Points at the same time.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION?

Transportation is available to some magnet programs. **BEFORE MAKING YOUR SELECTION**, contact the school or Transportation Services to determine if the magnet program offers transportation and if the closest pick-up/drop-off point is a reasonable distance from your home. For information about existing bus routes, contact Transportation Services Division at 1-800-LABUSES or (213) 580-2900.

District-paid transportation **MAY** be provided for ELEMENTARY (K-5/6) applicants if they reside outside a two-mile radius of the magnet program. District-paid transportation **MAY** be provided for SECONDARY (6-12) applicants if they reside outside a five-mile radius of the magnet program. Students attending the following span schools have a two-mile eligibility radius: Arroyo Seco, Laurel, Lake Balboa, Sherman Oaks CES, Western Ave and Westside Global Awareness.

Students with disabilities enrolling in a Magnet Program may also have access to transportation. Magnet programs may offer school to school transportation for eligible students.

NOTE: The maximum one-way riding time guideline for all students (grades Kindergarten through 12) is 90 minutes. This applies to all bus routes.

MAGNET PROGRAMS INFORMATION

MAGNET APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Do not submit a new application, if your child is currently enrolled in a magnet program and wishes to continue at the same school. Applicants currently enrolled in a magnet program who apply and are selected for another magnet program will automatically be dropped from their current magnet, whether they accept or decline.
- Applicants **MUST** be residents of Los Angeles Unified at the time of application and while participating in the magnet programs. **Post office boxes are not accepted.**
- Students selected to programs that have a uniform policy tied directly to their instructional program (CTE, Fire, Police, Medical, etc.) agree to abide by the policy.
- Pages 17-40 contain basic information about magnet programs to assist you in making a selection for your child. Although you have the option to select up to three different magnet programs, it is not mandatory for you to do so. Please see Selection Process section on page 18 for information on how the selection process handles the second or third choice(s) before you list an optional school on your application.
- Each magnet program's openings are determined by the need to maintain a racially balanced enrollment and by available space.
- Should an applicant leave the magnet program before completing the culminating grade, no matriculation points will be assigned.
- **Students on a waiting list may be contacted regarding an open seat through the first month of school. If an applicant declines magnet placement, ALL waiting list points are removed.**
- Applicants who still wish to apply to a magnet school or center after the November 12, 2021, deadline may submit a late application. **The late application will only allow for a single choice** and will open February 1, 2022. Available seats for late applicants will be open after all of the students on the waiting list have been offered placement at the selected school site. Each magnet's openings are determined by the need to maintain a racially balanced enrollment and by available space. Filling out a late application does not guarantee student placement and magnet priority points are not assigned.
- ◆ Full school elementary magnets with residential kindergarten give priority to students residing in the attendance boundary. Students currently enrolled in kindergarten have priority admission to 1st grade. Please see pages 21-40 to locate full school elementary magnets with residential kindergarten.
- ★ Continuous enrollment magnet schools accept applications throughout the school year. A continuous enrollment magnet school gives priority to students residing within its attendance boundary. All other eligible Los Angeles Unified applicants will be selected provided space is available. Please see pages 21-40 to locate continuous enrollment magnet schools.
- ⓔ The International Baccalaureate Programme Organization (IBO) offers three levels of international education that span the primary, middle and secondary school years. Authorization to become an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School is an intensive process that typically takes two or more years and includes site visits by an IB team. A regular process of evaluation is undertaken by schools that have been authorized.

COMPTON UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (CUSD) APPLICANTS

Los Angeles Unified, in cooperation with the Compton Unified School District (CUSD), offers a limited number of 9th grade openings at the King-Drew Magnet High School of Medicine and Science. These openings are **ONLY** available to residents of CUSD.

If you are interested in having your child participate in the program, please complete the Choices application with King-Drew Magnet as the only choice. Students applying to the program must submit a report card from their current school from the first semester of 8th grade. Report cards may be submitted via mail to Los Angeles Unified School District, Student Integration Services, 333 S. Beaudry Ave., 25th Floor, Los Angeles, CA 90017 or email to echoices@lausd.net to the attention of Compton/King-Drew Application. It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to ensure that Student Integration Services receives both the application and report card. The information submitted will be verified with CUSD.

CUSD resident students who are selected for the King-Drew Magnet High School of Medicine and Science are not eligible for transportation.

PERMITS WITH TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

WHAT IS THE PWT PROGRAM?

Permits With Transportation (PWT) is one of Los Angeles Unified's original integration programs and was established as a Court-Order to provide students with integrated school experiences within our district. PWT school assignments are made by the District to one of the following schools: Revere MS, Portola MS or Taft HS. The PWT program does not provide transportation to magnets or any other Choices program.

WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM?

PWT students are enrolled in the regular school program and may take part in all programs and activities available to resident students at the school where they are selected. Students and parents are encouraged to participate in all school/community activities at the PWT school.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students who are in grades 6-12 during the 2021-2022 school year and reside within the following Los Angeles Unified resident school boundary sending areas are eligible to apply for the PWT program:

Middle School Sending Areas:

Audubon, Drew, Gompers, Harte Prep, Mann, Muir and Obama Global

High School Sending Areas:

Ánimo College Prep., Crenshaw, Dorsey, Jordan, Locke, Manual Arts and Washington Prep.

HOW ARE STUDENTS SELECTED?

PWT priority selection is given to matriculating PWT students and students with siblings in the PWT program, while continuing at the same PWT school during the same year. The remaining PWT seats will be assigned randomly.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

- Do not submit a new application if your child is currently enrolled in the PWT program and wishes to continue at the same school.
- Applicants currently enrolled in the PWT program who apply and are selected to a Magnet program will automatically be dropped from their current PWT program, whether they accept or decline. PWT does not accept any late Choices applications.
- If selected, parent/guardian may accept or decline online or by calling the school by the deadline on the selection letter. **If the parent/guardian does not respond by the deadline, it will be considered a decline.**
- Applicants **MUST** be residents of Los Angeles Unified at the time of application and while participating in the PWT program. **Post office boxes are not accepted.**

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION?

Yes, PWT is a program that provides transportation to the following non-PHBAO schools: Portola MS, Revere MS and Taft High School.

DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCATION PROGRAMS INFORMATION

WHAT ARE DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCATION PROGRAMS?

Dual Language Education refers to programs that provide grade-level content and literacy instruction in two languages, in English and the target language. Students develop and strengthen their cognitive, academic, and sociocultural competence in an environment where cultural and linguistic assets are recognized. Los Angeles Unified is proud to offer wide-ranging Dual Language Education programs that provide students with opportunities to develop the multilingual and multicultural skills necessary to be successful in a global society.

This brochure provides a resource for families who want to find out more and apply to pathways where their children can become bilingual/biliterate and culturally competent. Currently, there are more than 200 Dual Language Education programs in grades Transitional Kindergarten (TK) -12 available in the following program models: Two-Way Immersion, One-Way Immersion, and World Language Immersion. The programs are offered in Spanish, Korean, Mandarin, French, Armenian, Arabic, and Japanese. New programs are added each year.

Dual Language Education programs are located on regular school campuses with access to activities and experiences shared with the host school. Please review the following pages to determine the programs that fit your child's needs. For more information regarding a specific program at a given school site, please call the school using the telephone number listed under the school's name on pages 47-56 in this brochure.

WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM?

One of the District's goals is to increase the number of graduating seniors who are bilingual and biliterate. As students continue to participate in Dual Language Education programs from TK to 12th grade, they reach advanced levels of academic and language proficiency in both languages and gain sociocultural understanding and competence. The Pathway to Biliteracy begins in K/1st grades. Students are recognized in Kindergarten for their commitment to bilingualism, and in first grade for their commitment to biliteracy. The Pathway to Biliteracy Award is given to students in 5/6 and 8th grades. The Los Angeles Unified and California Department of Education State Seal of Biliteracy are awarded to students in 12th grade.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

WHAT TYPES OF DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCATION PROGRAMS ARE AVAILABLE AND WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

LANGUAGE DESIGNATIONS: English Learner (EL), English Only (EO), Initially Fluent English Proficient (IFEP), Reclassified Fluent English Proficient (RFEP)

Dual Language Two-Way Immersion Program: Classroom Composition

The Dual Language Two-Way Immersion program is designed to provide students the opportunity to receive grade-level standards-based content in English and in a language other than English (target language). This program is designed for both English Learners (ELs) as well as English Speakers (EO, IFEP, and RFEP).

- Grades TK, K, and 1 — English Learners (ELs) who speak the target language of the program and English Speakers (EO, IFEP, RFEP) are eligible to participate.
- Grades 2-12 — English Learners (ELs) who speak the target language of the program are eligible to participate.
- Grades 2-12 — English Speakers (EO, IFEP, and RFEP) may enter the program if their target language performance is on par with peers who are already in the program. To determine eligibility, a target language assessment will be administered to students who have not previously participated in a Dual Language Education program.
- By the application deadline, if there are fewer than 50 percent of English Learners or English Speakers to create a balanced classroom composition, the ratio of assignment will be composed of up to 2/3 from either language group.

- Grades 2-12 — English Speakers (EO, IFEP, RFEP) may enter the program if their target language performance is on par with students who are already in the program. To determine eligibility, a target language assessment will be administered to students who have not previously participated in a Dual Language Education program.

HOW ARE STUDENTS SELECTED?

Selection preferences for applicants will be applied in the following order:



DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCATION PROGRAMS INFORMATION

If there are more qualified applicants than spaces available at the school, a random, unbiased selection process will be conducted. Siblings of current students in the dual language program have priority for attendance. There is no priority point accrual process for Dual Language Education programs. If there are more applicants than spaces available for a given grade, students will be placed on a waiting list.

- The waiting list number is not disclosed.
- Students will remain on the waiting list for their first choice with an on-time application even if offered a seat at another program with a late application.
- Schools will notify parents of students who applied with an on-time or with a late application who are on the waiting list, when a space becomes available. No further action is necessary for parents of students on the on-time or late waiting list.

Reseda Charter High School offers an International Center for Dual Language (Newcomer) Program for Spanish speaking students. Student selection, enrollment and placement must be conducted in accordance with State and District legal requirements established for charter schools. If a student is selected for Reseda Charter High School and meets the Dual Language Program eligibility criteria, this student must be accommodated in the International Center for Dual Language program. To apply for Reseda Charter HS or learn more about Affiliated Charter enrollment procedures, please refer to the Affiliated Charter Schools section of the Choices brochure on pages 67-70.

Enrollment Criteria

■ **Language Classification**

A student's official language classification is determined at the school following enrollment.

■ **Students Requiring Inter-District Permit**

Once placement has been offered, applicants who reside outside the Los Angeles Unified boundaries must complete the Inter-District Permit process to finalize enrollment at the assigned school. - Some Dual Language Education program schools offer Transitional Kindergarten (TK). Please contact the school for age requirements and additional information.
- Some Dual Language Education program schools offer Expanded Transitional Kindergarten (ETK). Please contact the Early Childhood Education Division at (213)241-0415 for application information. ETK programs are not part of the Choices application process.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION?

BEFORE MAKING YOUR SELECTION, PLEASE NOTE THAT TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED FOR DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

Exceptions:

- Students with disabilities enrolling in a Dual Language Education program will have access to transportation if the student's IEP requires transportation.
- Under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), foster youth in out-of-home care, as defined, and youth experiencing homelessness have the right to receive transportation to and from their school of origin. 

SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES INFORMATION

WHAT ARE SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES?

Gifted/talented students demonstrate evidence of high achievement in an identified area and need specialized services and support to fully develop their potential and support their academic success. Gifted/Talented Programs, Advanced Learning Options, is committed to ensuring that the unique academic and social-emotional needs of gifted/talented learners are met in every K-12 District school, including local schools of residence. Each Los Angeles Unified school with identified or verified gifted learners, regardless of program type, must cluster-group gifted learners for instruction and provide meaningful differentiated learning opportunities that challenge students to achieve beyond grade-based standards and expectations.

Schools for Advanced Studies demonstration sites receive the SAS designation for their exemplary Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) implementation. The Schools for Advanced Studies designation, initially implemented in the 1998–1999 school year, was created to acknowledge exemplary school models of innovative, equitable and effective GATE practices districtwide. By providing high-quality differentiated instruction with an emphasis on depth, complexity, acceleration and novelty, SAS sites offer high-level academic opportunities that meet the unique educational needs of K–12 gifted learners, identified in the Intellectual Ability, High Achievement Ability, Specific Academic Ability, Creative Ability and Leadership Ability categories or verified based on achievement or critical thinking and problem-solving skills. Resident schools must undergo a rigorous application process every five years to obtain or maintain the SAS designation.

WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM?

The goal of Gifted/Talented Programs is to identify gifted and talented students, including those from diverse racial, socioeconomic, linguistic and cultural backgrounds, and to provide high-quality differentiated opportunities for learning that develop and advance students' unique abilities and talents.

The Schools for Advanced Studies designation reflects the District's commitment to ensure equitable access, excellence and accountability to high-quality GATE programs districtwide. SAS sites serve as District demonstration centers for innovative and research-based differentiated curriculum and instruction for gifted/high ability learners in multiple categories. Schools for Advanced Studies sites have a proven commitment and ability to offer a sustained, highly effective, exemplary GATE program that includes essential GATE program components: 1) Gifted Identification, 2) Instruction and Academic Achievement of GATE Learners, 3) Knowledgeable and Skilled Staff in Gifted Education and 4) Parent, Family and Community Engagement.

Differentiation is an essential part of ensuring that the unique educational needs of gifted/talented students are appropriately addressed in the GATE/SAS classroom. Differentiated programming is not "more of the same" or simply acceleration of content/pacing, but also includes depth, complexity and novelty. GATE/SAS cluster grouping allows schools to provide more challenging coursework, giving gifted/high ability learners daily access to advanced content and new learning, as well as providing students with an academic peer group in core subjects.

HOW ARE TEACHERS TRAINED?

Gifted/talented learners must be taught by knowledgeable teachers, skilled in differentiating curriculum and instruction to support and advance their learning. As such, GATE professional development—specialized training about gifted/talented learners and how they learn best—is an essential and ongoing part of the expectations for SAS teachers and administrators. Each school's GATE program must be supported by administrators, GATE coordinator and instructional support staff with developed expertise in GATE. SAS teachers and administrators are required to participate annually in professional development specifically tailored to address the unique academic and social-emotional needs of gifted/talented learners to ensure that the curriculum and instruction (content, process and product) are thoughtfully differentiated to promote a culture of rigor, achievement and innovation.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Students residing within the school boundaries of a designated SAS site who meet the eligibility criteria must be placed in the site's SAS gifted/talented program (unless a parent has opted out). All qualified students residing within school boundaries must be accommodated before any applicants from outside school boundaries are enrolled. **No formal application is required for a qualified student residing within school boundaries since SAS is the school site's GATE instructional program for its students.**
- All students in grades PreK–11 who reside within Los Angeles Unified boundaries but outside school boundaries and who meet one of three eligibility criteria are eligible to apply for SAS participation for the following year. For SAS applicants, the teacher and principal of a student's current school of attendance are responsible for determining if the student meets at least one of the three eligibility criteria.
- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of private school, independent charter and non-Los Angeles Unified applicants (including incoming kindergarten SAS applicants) to ensure that the appropriate **Verification of Eligibility** form **AND** Choices application are submitted by the deadline. Homeschooled applicants or applicants not enrolled in PreK/TK may contact GATE@lausd.net for verification information.
- For information regarding verification of eligibility, refer to pages 7-8 of this brochure.

SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES INFORMATION

SAS APPLICANTS MUST MEET AT A MINIMUM ONE OF THREE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

FOR AN APPLICANT TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES, THE STUDENT MUST BE VERIFIED AS MEETING ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA PRIOR TO FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2021, AT 5:00 P.M.

- (A) Student is identified as gifted by a Los Angeles Unified designated GATE psychologist in the Intellectual Ability, High Achievement Ability, Specific Academic Ability, Creative Ability or Leadership Ability category. OR**
- (B) Student received total national percentile scores of 85 or above on a District-approved standardized achievement test in 2021, if applicable. Note: Due to the elimination of the 2020-2021 Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC), this criterion has been modified for this year only. OR**
- (C) Student demonstrates the ability to meet ALL FOUR critical thinking and problem-solving skills (in primary language):**
 - a) Explain meanings or relationships among facts, information or concepts that demonstrate depth and complexity
 - b) Formulate new ideas or solutions and elaborate on the information
 - c) Use alternative methods in approaching new or unfamiliar mathematical problems
 - d) Use extensive vocabulary easily and accurately to express creative ideas

The school of attendance will determine if your child demonstrates all four skills for this criterion (i.e., four critical thinking and problem-solving skills). Applicants verified through the four critical thinking and problem-solving skills criterion must also demonstrate the ability or strong potential to work two years above grade level in academic subjects. NOTE: Kindergarten SAS applicants must also be verified using the SAS kindergarten-specific criteria on the **Verification of Eligibility (SAS Kindergarten)** form. The recommendation submitted by the current school of attendance is final.

To ensure equity and access, each of the three SAS eligibility criteria carries equal weight in the selection process. Therefore, priority placement cannot be given to students identified as gifted/highly gifted or those who meet test score criteria. KINDERGARTEN SAS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Schools for Advanced Studies is a K-12 site designation. Transitional kindergarten (TK) SAS classes are not available. All kindergarten SAS applicants must be verified by the administrator of the preschool or the transitional kindergarten program as meeting the eligibility criteria (i.e., all four critical thinking and problem-solving skills), as well as a minimum of 10 out of 20 SAS kindergarten-specific criteria:

- Can work independently with evidence of goal-directed behavior
- Uses descriptive words in sentences and uses language to express emotions, ideas and opinions (in primary language)
- Can tell or retell a story with detailed description and expression (in primary language)
- Can recognize and repeat complex patterning sequences and create own patterns
- Can follow multi-step directions with little guidance or redirection
- Identifies the letters A to Z, knows the sounds of all of the letters of the alphabet and can write many of the letters
- Able to orally count to 100, visually identify numbers from 1 to 100 and write numbers 1 to 25
- Demonstrates innate or accelerated understanding of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Able to remember information and experiences (e.g., can recite song lyrics, recall facts) and make connections
- Able to recognize sight words and read with fluency and comprehension

SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES BY GRADE LEVEL

HOW ARE STUDENTS SELECTED?

SAS applicants who meet eligibility criteria and who reside outside school boundaries, but within Los Angeles Unified boundaries, may be selected for participation after students residing within the boundaries of a designated SAS site are accommodated.

If spaces are available, a selection process for qualifying SAS applicants will be conducted in this order:

- ① Siblings residing within Los Angeles Unified boundaries (must meet SAS eligibility criteria)
- ② Students residing within Los Angeles Unified boundaries (must meet SAS eligibility criteria)

If there are more qualified applicants than spaces available at the school, a random, unbiased selection process will be conducted. Siblings of current students in the same school/program have priority for attendance so long as resident students are not displaced. There is no priority point accrual process for Schools for Advanced Studies. Priority points are used by the Magnet Program only.

HOW DO I APPLY TO AN AFFILIATED CHARTER SITE WITH THE SAS DESIGNATION?

Student selection, enrollment and placement in the site's SAS gifted/talented program at Affiliated Charter Schools must be conducted in accordance with State and District legal requirements established for charter schools. If a student is selected for a designated SAS site through the Affiliated Charter process and meets one of the SAS eligibility criteria, this student must be accommodated in the site's SAS gifted/talented program. For Affiliated Charter School enrollment procedures, please refer to the Affiliated Charter Schools section of the Choices brochure on pages 67-70.

HOW DO I APPLY TO A ZONES OF CHOICE SITE WITH THE SAS DESIGNATION?

If a parent would like their child to attend a Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) site within their Zone of Choice (ZOC), the 5th, 6th or 8th grade student must select that site as their first choice during the ZOC selection process. If a student is assigned to a designated SAS site through this ZOC process and meets one of the SAS eligibility criteria, this student must be accommodated in the site's SAS gifted/talented program. Placement appeals through the ZOC office will not be considered if student did not select the SAS site as their first choice on the ZOC application. WHAT ARE AFFILIATED CHARTER SCHOOLS?

Affiliated Charter Schools are semi-autonomous District public schools that converted to affiliated charter status via a charter petition process. The schools are authorized by the Los Angeles Unified Board of Education. Affiliated Charter Schools are governed by the Board of Education and operate in accordance with District policy, Board Rules, state and federal law, collective bargaining agreements, and Human Resources/Personnel Commission guidelines. Affiliated Charter Schools receive direct oversight by a Local District Office and the Los Angeles Unified Charter Schools Division. The schools are given flexibility in the utilization of the charter school categorical block grant; areas of curriculum and professional development; some aspects of local school governance; and some aspects of employee selection.

WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM?

Each Affiliated Charter School has specific goals for the instructional program outlined in the school's charter petition and in the school's annually revised Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP).

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All students that reside in the State of California are eligible to apply to attend an Affiliated Charter School. However, the school must first serve students that reside within the Affiliated Charter School's former attendance boundary. Parents who live in the Affiliated Charter School's resident attendance boundary do not need to apply and directly contact the school for enrollment.

Parents who live outside of the Affiliated Charter School's attendance boundary apply through the Unified Enrollment application. The school, in coordination with the District, determines if additional space is available. If there is more interest in enrollment from non-resident families than there is space available, the school must hold a random public lottery for the remaining spaces. In the lottery, the remaining spaces are offered to students that live within Los Angeles Unified's attendance boundary before other students. It is not necessary to use the District's permit process to apply or be selected for admission to an Affiliated Charter School.

HOW ARE STUDENTS SELECTED?

- Parents must apply during the on-time application window online at <http://goto.lausd.net> or by submitting a paper application.
- To apply to multiple Affiliated Charter Schools, you must apply online.
- When applying to multiple Affiliated Charter Schools, there is no order of preference, on-time applicants will be entered into the lottery at each school they applied to.
- The school will publish the date and time of the lottery on their website and in the main office.
- Attendance at the lottery is preferred but is not required.
- All lotteries will be conducted during the month of February, annually.
- At the lottery, all applications will be grouped in priority order and randomly pulled to fill the remaining available spaces and to generate a waiting list. Students will remain on the waiting list for one school year only.
- In addition to District-wide priorities, each Affiliated Charter School may have additional lottery priorities included in their individual charter petition.
- If the space available exceeds the number of interested families (i.e. 30 spaces available and 10 families apply), a lottery is not needed. Those families will be contacted to complete the enrollment process within the appropriate timeline.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION?

TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED FOR AFFILIATED CHARTER SCHOOLS.

Exceptions:

- Students with disabilities enrolling in an Affiliated Charter School will have access to transportation if the student's Individual Education Plan (IEP) requires transportation.
- Under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), foster youth in out-of-home care, as defined, and youth experiencing homelessness have the right to receive transportation to and from their school of origin. The K-12 Open Enrollment Process is a state-mandated program allowing students anywhere in Los Angeles Unified to apply to any regular, grade-appropriate Los Angeles public school with designated open enrollment seats. Parents or guardians who want to enroll their child at a school other than their current school of attendance must complete an open enrollment application.

- The on-time application period begins in the first week of May for schools with designated Open Enrollment available seats. For schools where applications exceed the declared number of Open Enrollment seats, a random electronic drawing will be held in early June.
- Coordinated by School Management Services/Master Planning and Demographics Office as an alternative enrollment option to resident schools.
- Check the website, <http://achieve.lausd.net/k12OpenEnrollment>, or go to any Los Angeles Unified school in the first week of May for a list of participating schools, instructions on how to apply online and the number of Open Enrollment seats at each school. 
